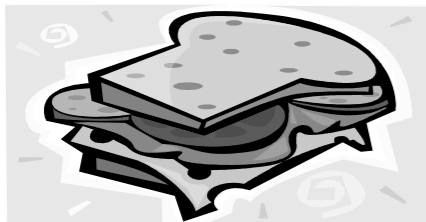

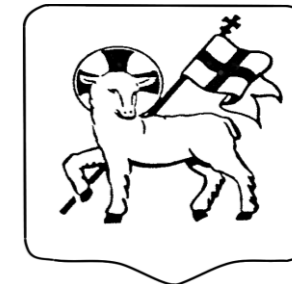
Glenway Gate Open House


